

Chestnut

Line Dance for 3 Couples

- I. A - Partners lead up a Double and fall back a Double. That again.
B1 - Back away from your Partner a Double, then cross and change places. Men take hands and circle once around, the Women doing the same at the same time.
B2 - Repeat back to your places.

- II. A - Arm right with your Partner. Arm left with your Partner.*

B1 - Back away from your Partner a Double, then cross and change places. Each side do a half Hey so 1st Couple ends at the bottom.

B2 - Repeat back to your places.

- III. A - Side right with partner. Side left with partner.

B1 - Back away from your Partner a Double, then cross and change places. 1st Couple lead down the center, the other Couples following.

B2 - Repeat, casting off and follow up to your places.
